Proposed Changes to Ridgeline Construction Limits

The Planning Department and the Planning Board held a number of day and evening public meetings in August across the county addressing recently adopted changes to sections of the Land Use Regulations, including changes in the distance from the top of a ridge a structure can be built. In light of the fact that several people have expressed their concerns about these changes, the Board of County Commissioners have asked for additional September reviews.

Public meetings will be held by the Park County Planning Board at 9 am on Tuesday, September 8th and by the Park County Board of Commissioners on Thursday, September 17, 2009 to further discuss these proposed revisions. The proposed changes will be posted on the county website before the Planning Commission meeting.
