**A RESOLUTION IMPOSING A TEMPORARY  
SUSPENSION ON THE PROCESSING AND APPROVAL  
OF ANY PARK COUNTY PERMIT OR LICENSE FOR  
AN OUTDOOR EVENT AND DECLARING THE  
INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS TO CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF  
APPROPRIATE COUNTY REGULATIONS WITH  
RESPECT TO SUCH OUTDOOR EVENTS**

WHEREAS, Park County requires the issuance of a temporary use permit as a prerequisite to the holding of an Outdoor Event, as that term is defined in 4-200 of the Park County Land Use Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been made aware that a number of Outdoor Events have occurred in the County in recent months which far exceed the number of attendees experienced at such events in the past; and

WHEREAS, the County's current regulations regarding Outdoor Events do not adequately address Outdoor Events of the scope and size experienced in recent months; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of a temporary suspension of the submission, acceptance, processing, and approval of all applications for County permits and licenses relating to Outdoor Events will allow the County staff and the Board of County Commissioners to draft new regulations governing such Outdoor Events and to solicit input from the public, the promoters and sponsors of such events, and emergency services providers; and

WHEREAS, a suspension through and including January 1, 2015 is a reasonable length of time and no longer than necessary for the County to properly investigate, develop, and, if appropriate, adopt and implement new regulations with respect to Outdoor Events; and

WHEREAS, promoters and sponsors of Outdoor Events will not be unduly prejudiced by the imposition of such suspension.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PARK COUNTY, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. Findings and Intent. The above and foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference and adopted as findings and determinations of the Board of County Commissioners of Park County.

Section 2. Imposition of Temporary Suspension of Applications for Permits and Licenses Related to Outdoor Events. Upon the adoption of this Resolution, a suspension is imposed upon the processing and approval of all applications for permits and licenses by the County related to an Outdoor Events. County staff is directed to refuse to accept for filing, and not to process or review, any such applications for the period beginning with the date of adoption of this Resolution through and including January 1, 2015.

Section 3. Staff to Investigate and Prepare Proposed Regulations. Before the expiration of the suspension imposed by this Resolution, County staff, working with the County Attorney, shall prepare appropriate regulations for Outdoor Events for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 4. Police Power Finding. The Board of County Commissioners hereby finds, determines and declares that this Resolution is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the order, comfort and convenience of the County and the inhabitants thereof.


Section 5. Authority. The Board of County Commissioners hereby finds, determines and declares that it has the power to adopt this Resolution pursuant to: (i) the Local Government Land Use Control Enabling Act, Article 20 of Title 29 C.R.S.; (ii) Part 1 of Article 28 of Title 30, C.R.S. (concerning county zoning powers); and (iii) Article 15 of Title 30, C.R.S. (concerning county police powers).
