Resolution No. 2015 29**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING REGULATIONS
AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING THE REMOVAL, STORAGE
AND DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED OR ILLEGALLY PARKED
MOTOR VEHICLES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.**

WHEREAS, Part 18, Article 4, Title 42 of the Colorado Revised Statutes (“Part 18”) provides procedures for the removal, storage, and disposal of motor vehicles that are abandoned on public property; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 42-4-1813(2) states that: “The provisions of this Part 18 may be superseded by ordinance or resolution of . . . any county that sets forth procedures for the removal, storage, and disposal of abandoned or illegally parked motor vehicles on public property;” and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to establish local procedures governing the removal, storage, and disposal of abandoned or illegally parked motor vehicles on public property as allowed by C.R.S. § 42-4-1813(2);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF PARK THAT:

Section 1. The procedures for removal, storage, and disposal of abandoned or illegally parked motor vehicles on public property in Park County shall be as set forth in Part 18, Article 4, Title 42 of the Colorado Revised Statutes except as set forth in this Resolution.

Section 2. The amount of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) referred to in C.R.S. § 42-4-1805(2) and (3) is reduced to one dollar (\$1.00).

Section 3. The Procedures set forth in C.R.S. § 42-4-1809(2)(a)(c) and (d); C.R.S. § 42-4-1810(4)(b); and C.R.S. § 42-4-1811 shall not apply to the disposition of abandoned vehicles in Park County.

Section 4. Prior to any sale or disposition of a motor vehicle pursuant to Part 18 the Park County Office shall mail notice of such intended sale or disposition to the registered owner of the motor vehicle by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to such owner’s last known address as shown by public records. No sooner than thirty (30) days following the mailing of the notice, the motor vehicle may be sold, or become property of the County of Park, in the Sheriff’s discretion.

Section 5. Proceeds from the sale of any motor vehicle pursuant to Part 18 shall, after payment of all valid and operator's fees and perfected liens and security interests, be paid to the Park County Sheriff's Office with such proceeds to be used for the purchase of law enforcement materials and equipment.


