**DISASTER DECLARATION**  
**RESOLUTION DECLARING LOCAL DISASTER**  
**RESOLUTION #2015- 30**

WHEREAS, the Park County Emergency Manager and/or County Administration Officer has advised the Board of County Commissioners of Park County ("the Board") of a disaster (as that term is defined in Part 7 of Article 33.5 of Title 24, C.R.S.) currently present in the unincorporated area of Park County, to wit, the occurrence or imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from Flooding requiring emergency action to avert danger or damage, which occurred between April 28<sup>th</sup> and June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015 and;

WHEREAS, the cost and magnitude of responding to and recovery from the impact of Flooding is far in excess of the county's available resources; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Manager and County Administration Officer has recommended that the Board declare a local disaster; and WHEREAS, it would be appropriate and in the interests of the public health and safety, and would further protect property, for the Board to implement said recommendation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709 and the emergency management and operations plans and resolutions of Park County, Colorado the Board is authorized to declare a local disaster.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. That the Board hereby declares that there is a local disaster in the unincorporated area of Park County, to wit, the occurrence or imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from Flooding requiring emergency action to avert danger or damage.
2. The effect of this declaration of disaster shall be to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local and inter-jurisdictional disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under such plans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the principal executive officers of all other towns in Park County affected by said disaster are urged to proclaim similar declarations and to cooperate with Park County as necessary

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
