**A RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY APPROVING AN OUTDOOR  
EVENT PERMIT FOR THE ELSEWHENCE EVENT TO BE HELD  
ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2015 TO SEPTEMBER 20, 2015 ON REAL  
PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE APPLICATION.**

WHEREAS, the Applicant/Owner, David Wellhauser/Berger Land Company, has applied to conduct an Outdoor Event on September 18, 2015 through September 20, 2015; and

WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled public meeting of the Park County Board of County Commissioners, preceded by the required public notice, the Board of County Commissioners conducted a public hearing on the application for an Outdoor Event Permit at which it reviewed the application and all supporting documentation, the recommendations of the Planning Department and the Park County Planning Commission, and considered the testimony of the Applicant and patrons; and

WHEREAS, based on the testimony and evidence presented at the public hearing the Board of County Commissioner determines and finds that compliance with the standards for approval of an Outdoor Event Permit set forth in Section 5-707 of the Park County Land Use Regulations has been demonstrated by clear and convincing evidence.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

The application for an Outdoor Event Permit is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions:

1. No ember producing fires are permitted.
2. Amplified sound is permitted between 12:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. only. ~~Non-~~ **All amplified personal sound devices shall comply with County and State regulations. *whether amplified or not***
3. Event duration, including set-up and take-down, shall occur between 7:00 a.m. on Friday of the event and dusk on Sunday at the event. Friday pre-noon activities are limited to set-up, and Sunday post-noon activities are limited to take-down and clean-up. It is noted that this is an exception to the generally permitted 48-hour duration for camping and music events.
4. Written approval of fire and security plans shall be obtained from Platte Canyon Fire Protection District and Park County Sheriff's Office respectively.
5. All trash shall be stored in bear-resistant containers after dark.
6. No "fire performances" (as described by Applicant's representatives during the public hearing) shall be allowed.

- 7. All representations regarding the conduct of the Outdoor Event made by the Permittee or its representatives, in the application or during the public hearing on the application, are incorporated herein and made a condition of the Outdoor Event Permit. Any failure by the Permittee to perform or comply with such representations or any other condition set forth herein shall be a violation of the Outdoor Event Permit and Regulations.
