We, the undersigned, acknowledge that the Outdoor Event operator and property owner shall be jointly and severally responsible for meeting the provisions of these standards and regulations, assuring that attendance does not exceed the maximum approved, for operational maintenance, for the clean, safe and sanitary condition of the grounds, sanitary facilities and other service equipment; fully implementing the fire, safety and medical plans; cooperating with law enforcement, medical personnel and fire safety staff; complying with all federal, state and local laws; and fully implementing the noise reduction, crowd control and traffic safety plans.

We understand that, in addition to any fines or penalties assessed under any other law or regulation, event organizers and landowners will be liable for all violations of the noise ordinance, State regulation, and/or noise limits applicable to the Outdoor Event, in the following amounts:

1. \$500 for the first offense, and
2. \$10,000 for the second offense and each subsequent offense.

We further understand that the permit may be revoked by an administrative decision finding that:

- a) The Outdoor Event has failed to comply with any condition of the Outdoor Event Permit and the applicant has not remedied the failure immediately following notification by

the County; or

b) The Outdoor Event has failed to comply with any federal, state, or local law and the applicant has not remedied the failure immediately following notification by the County.

- Payment – Payment to the Park County Sheriff’s Office for law enforcement staffing and other involved governmental entities must be received at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the event.
- Staff (Paid or volunteer) – Organizer will adequately staff required positions. Staff will be instructed to assist in staging a safe and orderly event. Staff must be easily identifiable through use of bib, shirt, vest or cap.
- Venues/Routes – Venue location/Routes for events will not be changed unless specific approval is given by the Director of Department Services or Designee, the Sheriff or Designee, or the Incident Commander or Designee may approve changes during the event.
- Times – Permits are issued with a set starting and ending time. These times cannot be changed without permission from the Planning Department, the Sheriff or the Incident Commander on the day of the event. Resumption of normal traffic in these areas will occur at the end time specified on the permit.

BAILEY DAY EVENT NARRATIVE

By Marcel Flukiger, Bailey Day Committee Member

Bailey Day will take place on June 25th, 2016, a single day event. Set-up on Main Street will start at noon on until around 6pm on Friday. The band stage will be placed in the center of Main Street in front of the Sasquatch Outpost, beer and wine tent along the side of the road in front of the Sasquatch Outpost. Some vendors chose to set up their booths on Friday evening, no security will be provided at this time. Main Street will be closed off Friday evening from Cutthroat Café to Knotty Pine, the entire Main Street will be closed all day Saturday. Saturday morning, vendors will be arriving at 8am, checking in front of Conoco, creating one way entry, proceeding to their assigned spots, lining both sides of Main Street between Conoco and Cutthroat Café. The street fair will kick off at 10am and will finish up at 9pm. Merchandise vendors, kid activities, live music and between band shows, beer and wine booth, duck pull, old tyme photo booth and Bailey Taste Off will be held on Main Street. The street fair will be finishing up around 4pm and vendors will start moving out on the South side of Main Street. At this time, event staff will direct attendees to the North end between Knotty Pine and Cutthroat Café and will continue the event with a street dance, live music, wine and beer booth and food vendors until 9pm. Remaining vendors will be moving out at that time and cleanup will be continued until 10pm, when Main Street will be reopened. Remaining cleanup will be finished up by noon on Sunday. Platte Canyon Area Chamber of Commerce is going to apply for a special events liquor license with the appropriate state and county agencies and will operate the beer and wine booth according to the Colorado liquor code.

Additional venues will include a 5K run on County Rd.64 on Saturday morning, 8am, followed by a pancake breakfast served by Platte Canyon Community Church.

McGraw Park will host numerous activities and hold an open house at the historical park. Foot traffic between Main Street and McGraw Park will be controlled by Park County Sheriff's Department for a safe crossing of Hwy 285.

Main parking area for the event will be located between Loaf & Jug and Crow Hill Bible Church, where a shuttle service, contracted with Platte Canyon School District will pick up street fair attendees and drop them off at Hwy 285 & Main Street by China Village. Handicapped parking will be located in front and on the side of Mountain Peace Boutique. Signs will be posted. No parking will be allowed along Hwy 285 and cones and no parking signs will be placed on Friday evening. Vendor parking will be located in the Road & Bridge department lot and along Main Street near the Bailey Business Center.

Porta Potties, roll-off dumpster and garbage cans will be delivered on Friday afternoon and placed in locations noted on event map. Event signs with directional arrows to parking area at Crow Hill Bible Church will be placed on Friday afternoon. Additional bathrooms will be accessible to the public at Sasquatch Outpost, Cutthroat Café, McGraw Park, Rustic Station Restaurant and Aspen Peak Cellars.

Event security will be provided by the Park County Sheriff's department, fire safety and medical emergency care by Platte Canyon Fire Department. State patrol and CDOT are made aware of the annual event and will help make travelers be aware of the special event in the area.

This year's event will not be combined with the Bailey Hundo as in the past few years. This separation will help the flow of the event from setup to cleanup. The Bailey Day Committee of the Platte Canyon Area Chamber of Commerce is looking forward to another smooth event without incidents.


