

PARK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE WEEKLY ACTIVITY REPORT JUNE 29, 2018 THROUGH JULY 5, 2018

Fire News

Beginning on Friday, June 29 the (formerly) Jones Hill fire grew quickly, becoming the Weston Fire that eventually grew to 12,702 acres according to <https://inciweb.nwcg.gov/>. Additionally the Chateau Fire started in Teller County on Friday. Deputies, Animal Control Deputies, Reserves and Auxiliaries were called out to both and were then involved in evacuations, livestock and pet evacuations, anti-looter patrol and road blockages until Wednesday July 4. Also assisting were Officers from Colorado State Patrol and Colorado Parks and Wildlife (DOW) and crews from Park County Road and Bridge and CDOT.

Assault, Bailey

A Deputy responded to a residence near Bailey for a report of an assault on the evening of Friday, June 29 and found the female victim with evidence of having been struck numerous times. After taking statements the area was checked for the named suspect, but the Deputy was unable to locate (UTL) him. The next day, Saturday, June 30, Deputies received a trespass-in-progress call at the same address and located the male suspect when they arrived on scene. The male party was arrested, transported to the Park County Jail and charged with *1st Degree Criminal Trespass* and *Criminal Mischief*.

DUI-D, Grant

On Saturday evening, June 30, a northbound Deputy observed a southbound vehicle near Grant following too closely and still having its headlights in the "bright" mode. The driver gave a verbal identification which Park County Communications was unable to find a match for and gave indications of impairment. He then refused roadsides and any chemical test. He was arrested for *Driving Under the Influence (Drugs)* and was transported to the Park County Jail.

DUI, Harris Park On Sunday, July 1 at approximately 11:30 PM a Deputy noticed a vehicle that matched the description of one who had reported a missing firearm at the Harris Park Gun Range. The male party had not been to the shooting range, but was the male party mentioned in an earlier complaint regarding child custody issues. The driver agreed to perform voluntary roadside maneuvers, but did not complete them in the manner a sober party would. He was arrested and charged with *DUI-D, Open Container* and *Child Abuse* because of the two small children in the vehicle. He was transported to the Park County Jail.
