

Guffey Gorge parking area is completed. The vault toilet was installed in fall 2016. Park County Road and Bridge completed moving the parking area entrance and blocking the other user created entrances with rocks. The new entry encourages water flow along the edge of the road and gives a safer line of sight to vehicles entering and leaving the north parking. Park Cty removed four trees and defined a loop parking area. Class 6 material was added to help minimize the water flow on the parking surface and more rock was placed to contain vehicles. Guffey Fire installed "Emergency vehicle only" signs at the gate entry to the west.

A BLM contractor completed the parking lot in November 2017. In front of the toilet, a culvert with additional material was added. This provides ADA access and provide additional water drainage control. Additional rock boulders were installed to further contain vehicles within the parking perimeter. The BLM entry sign, fee tube, kiosk structure and picnic table were installed in the north parking area has been installed.

Additional directional signs will be added by BLM along with informational panels in the kiosk.
