Approval of Agenda – Aric Stahley made a motion to approve, Ben Mulligan second. All in favor, passed.

Approval of Meeting Minutes - Ben Mulligan made a motion to approve, Paul Mattson second. All in favor. Passed.

Standing Reports (35 minutes):

Communications Center – Maria - Staffing at 6 full time. 2 interested, not applications yet. 1 of our team is out on extended medical leave.

Telecommunications – Maria – Maria has begun working with PCSO when they certify for fire arms training to also do radio use training. VHF radios coming out of patrol cars will be offered to Park Public works to replace their VHF radios that are older than these. Any “extra” will be offered to Fire or EMS agencies that have a need. These are old Kenwood VHF radios and we should all be looking at new vs old.

Brian Foltz with State OIT - Kenosha site is still in the works and will take a few years to build. The site will be where the current tower sits. The old tower will be torn down and replaced. The process includes updates to the Methodist site which is what is delaying the project overall. The Mt Bailey DTR antenna’s will need to be replaced this summer. The radio department will be moving from OIT to Dept of public safety.

GIS/Mapping – none

Public Health – Glenn – Covid19 Testing/Vaccinations:

- Affinity will end their testing services in Bailey on the last Wednesday in June.
- Contract testing will continue to be available through September 2022 at the Bailey & Fairplay Public Health offices on Mondays and Tuesdays using ATCG.
- Vax Clinics are set up in Bailey and Fairplay through the month of June.
- The CDPHE Bus will continue to provide vaccinations through December 2022

- In house vaccinations will continue to be discussed monthly weighing overall vaccination demand and new age groups 6m-4y into the picture

Other PCPH Areas:

- Received new 800 series radios and are training with them.
- Uptick in Dog Bites we have had 11 since March
- WIC: Formula shortage continues to be the biggest concern. Colorado WIC has made it as easy as possible to find formula by increasing the brands. PC WIC Coordinator has been available M-F for calls to help moms get the formula they are seeing on the shelf. Hopefully production will continue to increase to meet the current demand.
- Fentanyl Test Strips: working on obtaining data on fentanyl test strips (FTS). PH Staff are trying to find research that shows the use of Fentanyl Test Strips has efficacy in preventing OD. If they find the research then they would like talk with other organizations about having the FTS available for the public.

Mental Health – Paul Mattson - Working with Diversis to create an algorithm for first responders. Maria mentioned the mental health 3 digit number 988 which is the mental health/ suicide prevention hotline.

Emergency Management – Gene Stanley – ES Council Zoom meetings have been on the free platform. Gene will send a new zoom link using the county ZOOM platform.

C.D.F.P.C. – Brenda W – the red is gone from the Resource funding guidelines. The governor has provided additional funds. The current form was passed out in today’s meeting. DFPC receiving 5million dollars for fire suppression equipment which will be available to all, Shannon Byerly has joined DFPC as the resource ordering battalion chief.
