Question: On your RFPs and floor plans, I did not see markings to indicate potential locations for wireless access points. Can you identify locations for the wireless access points?

Answer: Below are the general evaluation results from an assessment done a couple of years ago for wireless access points in the four branches of Park County Public Library.

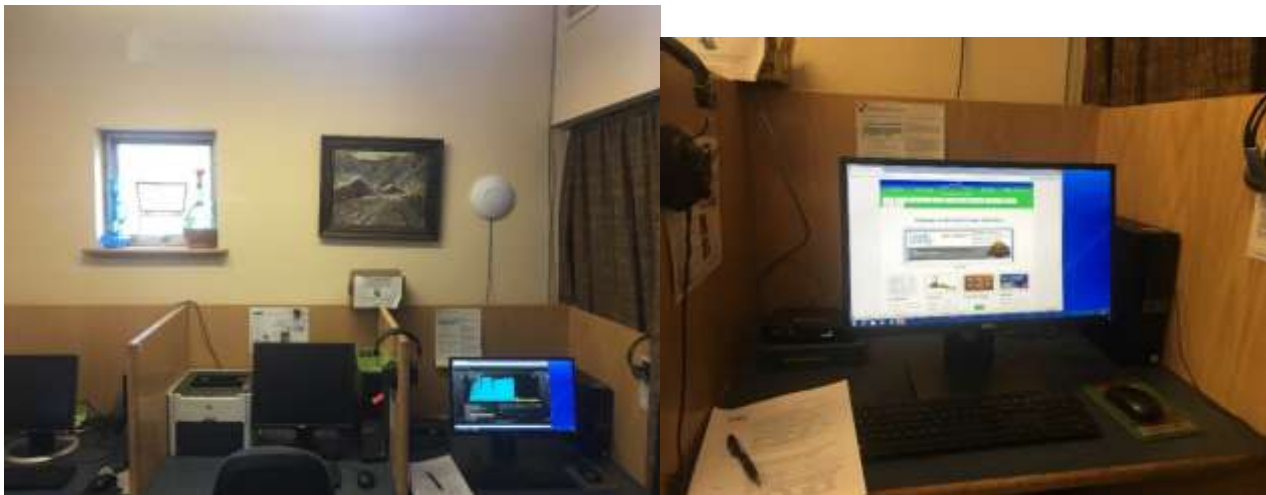
Park County Public Libraries – Lake George

Wifi Access Points –Possible Locations/Installation Notes to aid in project

Lake George – 2 Access point recommended PoE

AP1 – Replace existing access point but use 20 foot cable to relocate around corner which should give the table area by windows better coverage. Or replace existing access point and use AP2 to accommodate meeting area and parking lot. No outlets or ethernet drops by those tables in meeting area.



AP2-Improved coverage for meeting area within building and parking lot area where patrons use WIFI extensively.

Question 2: Will the Library provide the WAPs to be installed or is this RFP for purchase and installation, and is there a preferred Brand?
