

Question and Answer 1 regarding Bailey Library WAPs

Question: On your RFPs and floor plans, I did not see markings to indicate potential locations for wireless access points. Can you identify locations for the wireless access points?

Answer: Below are the general evaluation results from an assessment done a couple of years ago for wireless access points in the four branches of Park County Public Library.

Park County Public Libraries –Bailey

Wifi Access Points –Possible Locations/Possible Installation Notes to aid in project

Bailey – 4 Access Points recommended

AP1 – replace the existing wifi router in the closet downstairs



AP2-downstairs meeting room to get better coverage for meeting room and lower level parking lot.

AP3 – install upstairs in main library – ideally close to front door as possible to get better coverage out into parking lot. Didn't get picture by setup by Workforce Computer seems ideal for AP3

AP4-upstairs to get better coverage for the study/work area where library patrons often connect their devices using WIFI

Question 2: Will the Library provide the WAPs to be installed or is this RFP for purchase and installation, and is there a preferred Brand?
