

Question and Answer 1 regarding Fairplay Library WAPs

Question: On your RFPs and floor plans, I did not see markings to indicate potential locations for wireless access points. Can you identify locations for the wireless access points?

Answer: Below are the general evaluation results from an assessment done a couple of years ago for wireless access points in the four branches of Park County Public Library.

Park County Public Libraries – Fairplay

Wifi Access Points –Possible Locations/Possible Installation Notes to aid in project

Fairplay – 4 access Points recommended

AP1-Main Floor replace existing router in the backroom – will be PoE, Power over Ethernet



AP2-Main Floor meeting room where patrons often connect via WIFI

AP3 and AP4– Upstairs in attic, this will be to work around the Cinder block walls downstairs. Both can be connected here, one with 10 foot cable to center it and 2nd one at end of wall, towards front of building, power supply down there and will cover the parking lot.



Question and Answer 2 regarding Park County Public Library WAPs

Question 2: Will the Library provide the WAPs to be installed or is this RFP for purchase and installation, and is there a preferred Brand?
